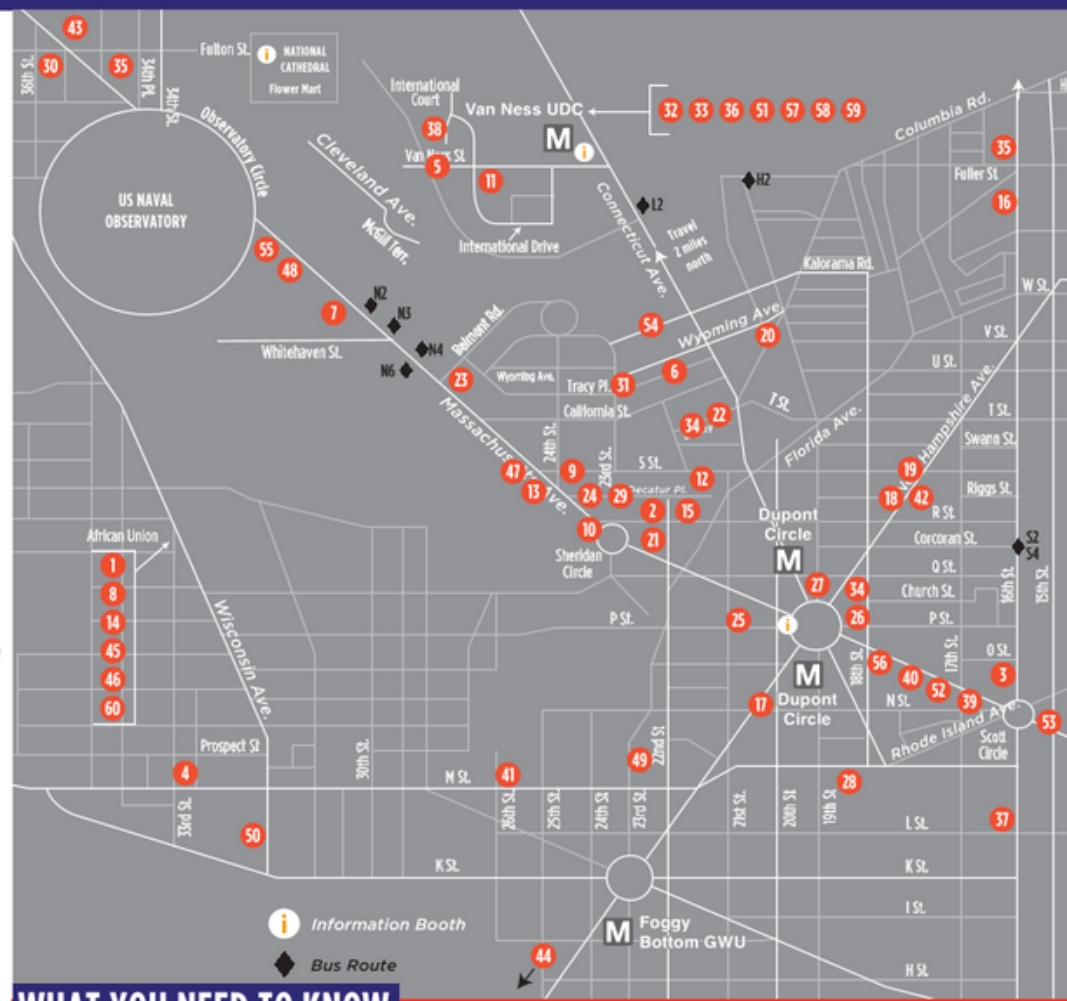

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- All embassies are open from 10:00 am to 4:30 pm.
- Admission is free.
- Street parking is available but limited near embassy locations. Many embassies are within walking distance of the Dupont Circle and UDC/Van Ness Metrorail stations.
- Embassies on International Drive are larger and often have shorter lines than those on Embassy Row.
- Embassies may require photo ID for admission. Generally, IDs are not needed for children accompanied by an adult. Please also bring a mask with you, as some embassies may require them for entry.
- Embassies may have items for sale, and some may accept cash only.

Get Your Passport Stamped! Pick up a Passport DC souvenir passport to get it stamped at the embassies you visit on May 4.
Passports are free and available at the following locations: Passport DC Information Hubs near the Dupont Circle and Van Ness-UDC Metrorail stations, the Mexican Cultural Institute and the International City Food Festival at The Square.
